Free Rides on OC Bus

Youth 18 and under can ride free on OC Bus as part of a special promotion that runs through the end of February 2022.

The **Youth Ride Free pass** is available at the OCTA store and online at [octa.net](https://www.octa.net).

Kids Ride Free on Metrolink on Weekends

Every weekend, families can take a Metrolink rail trip anywhere it goes for only \$10 per adult and the **kids 17 and under ride free** (up to three per paying adult).

Omnitrans Discounts for Students

Omnitrans fixed route buses are now free

for K-12 students. Students simply show a student ID to ride.

On **OmniRide**—reservation-based, on-demand shared transit service—students K-12 can ride for half price (so a one-way trip is \$2 with student ID).

Willowbrook/Rosa Parks Station Now Open

Metro last month opened a **newly renovated Willowbrook/Rosa Parks Station**, one of its busiest stations.

Now a state-of-the-art transit hub, it features a transit court, a modernized Park & Ride lot with electrical charging stations and upgraded security camera systems.

Willowbrook/Rosa Parks is served by the Metro A Line (Blue), Metro C Line (Green), Metro Bus, Metro Micro on demand service, and several local transit providers.



Save With OC Bus Welcome Pass



Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) is offering a **special pass through Nov. 15 that allows riders to save 40% over the usual OC Bus fares**.

A 5-Day Welcome Pass is only \$15 (a \$10 savings). The 30-Day Welcome Pass is \$40 (vs. \$69), to be used for 30 consecutive days once it is redeemed.

Metrolink Expands Ventura Line Saturday Service

Metrolink recently expanded its new Ventura County Line Saturday service. There are now more connections to and from three additional stations—Camarillo, Oxnard, and Ventura—East—to existing service between Moorpark and Los Angeles.

Prior to last May, Metrolink did not offer Saturday service on the Ventura County line.
