Join the thousands of commuters who will leave the solo drive behind and share the ride during Rideshare Week, Oct. 4-8.

Southern Californians on average spend 80 hours a year stuck in traffic tie-ups. Ridesharing lets you drive less, so you'll smile more.

You may be able to save time using the carpool lane (about 40 minutes a day for most)—or skip the drive altogether by riding transit, biking, walking or teleworking.

Los Angeles County

Track your commute using the Commute Calendar at ridematch.info—any day during Rideshare Week you choose an alternative to driving alone you'll qualify for a daily drawing to win a \$20 grocery gift card.

Orange County

Rideshare at least one day of the week and you'll be entered for a chance to win an Apple Watch or Apple AirPods Pro.

Riverside/San Bernardino Counties

Sign up and log your rideshare activity on IECommuter.org throughout October and you'll qualify to win any of dozens of prizes.
