Holiday Free and Discount Rides



Ring in the holiday season without the hassle of driving—plus get a bargain.

- **Metro will offer free rides** on bus and rail from 9 p.m. to 2 a.m. on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.
- **OC Bus** will offer free rides on New Year's Eve.
- On Christmas and New Year's Day, Metrolink will run on its weekend schedule and price—so it's **only \$10 to travel all day, anywhere Metrolink goes.**

Metro's Aviation/Century Station Now Open

Metro recently opened the Aviation/Century Station along its C and K rail lines. It's the first of two new stations aimed to provide better connections between the lines as well as to LAX.

Next to open will be the much-anticipated LAX/Metro Transit Center. (An opening date has not yet been

announced but construction is in its final phases and testing is underway.)

Once open, the LAX/Metro Transit Center will serve the C Line, K Line, and local buses run by Metro and other agencies. It will also eventually connect to airport terminals via the LAX people mover.
