Back to School – Free and Discount Rides for Students



Did you know...? Students can ride free or at a discount on many transit providers throughout Southern California. Here's how:

Metrolink

As part of a recent fare restructuring, Metrolink no longer offers free rides for students. However, students get a 50% discount—including K-12, trade school, college students and student interns—to travel anywhere on the Metrolink system, anytime.

Los Angeles County

With an active Metro **GoPass TAP card**, students at participating K-12 schools and community colleges can ride free on Metro Bus and Rail as well as on more than a dozen LA County transit providers.

Orange County

Youth ages 6-18 can ride free on OC Bus with a Youth Ride Free pass, available directly from participating schools or at [octa.net](https://www.octa.net).

Riverside County

Riverside Transit Agency's **Go-Pass/U-Pass** allows students attending participating colleges in Riverside County to ride free.

San Bernardino County

Students K-12 can ride free every day on every bus system in San Bernardino County. Find out more at [gosbcta.com](https://www.gosbcta.com).

Ventura County

The **Youth Ride Free program** allows youth 18 and under and those over 18 enrolled in high school to ride any public transit bus in Ventura County for free.

Out & About...

OC Fair Express—direct bus service to and from the fairgrounds—runs Saturdays and Sundays through Aug. 17. Fares are only \$2 each way (free for youth 18 and under). Catch it at locations in Anaheim, Huntington Beach, Laguna Hills, Fullerton and Santa Ana.
