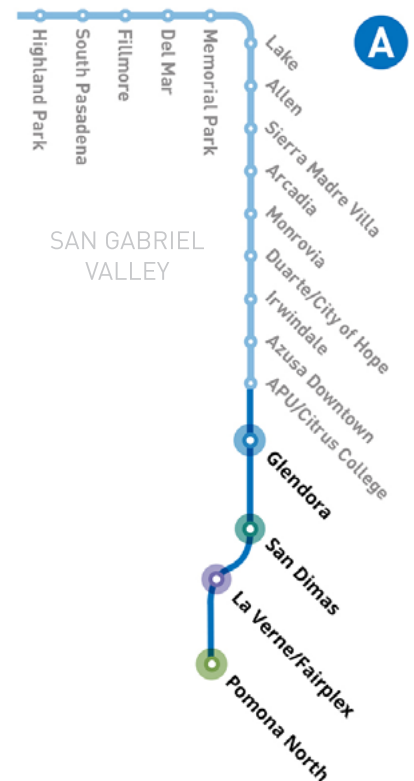

Metro A Line Extension Opening Soon

The nation's longest light rail line is getting longer! Metro's A Line Extension to Pomona will open on Sept. 19.

The **A Line Extension** adds more than 9 miles of track and four new stations in Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne and Pomona.

Riders will be able to transfer between Metro and Metrolink at the Pomona Station, giving everyone a new, faster way to ride between the Inland Empire and Foothill Cities corridor.
